S106 Funding

As I know you are aware, a sum of £355k has been allocated to Community Facilities from the Littlecombe Development (S.15/0476/OUT). Dursley Town Council are currently working together with Stroud District Council and Cam Parish Council on a fair and transparent process to allocate this funding.

Therefore to provide you with an update, the Town Council have supplied Stroud District Council a proposed list of potential locations/projects which this funding could be allocated, in alphabetical order:

Community Centre – Upgrading Facility.
Listers Hall/Chantry Centre – Upgrading Facility.
Kingshill House – Upgrading Facility.
The Tabernacle – Upgrading Facility and New Lift.
Town Hall - New Lift.

This list had to be supplied to SDC by the end of November and it was not possible to provide a list of finalised schemes before this deadline. Cam PC have also been asked to supply a list for potential schemes within their parish.

It is anticipated that your organisations and any other interested parties will be invited to apply for funding early in 2016 with a view to the allocation process being completed by the end of April 2016. This will provide you with a more realistic timescale to prepare and submit your application, however I would advise you commence with your preparation of your applications. We will be requesting evidence of your business planning, sustainability, governance and the project details.

I will be in contact early in the new year to provide more details of the application process and timeline.
